

### BASIN ELECTRIC POWER COOPERATIVE SCHOLARSHIP

The Basin Electric Power Cooperative scholarship is for graduating seniors. This scholarship will award an applicant with one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to further the student's education at a certified vocational or technical school.

#### **TRI-STATE G&T SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for graduating seniors. A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to two applicants enrolling in ANY post-secondary accredited institution having at least a one-year degree program.

The new year is sure to bring new challenges and I'm proud to say Carbon has the Employee team and Board of Directors to meet 2019 with enthusiasm.




