The location of your electric line is a member courtesy and we take no responsibility for your electric lines.

Our afterhours outage service center representatives have the ability to ping the meter to see if it has voltage. If the representative informs you, the meter responded okay, you may still request a call from a Carbon Lineman.

We are completing a storage building in Saratoga we have been planning this addition for several budget cycles and we are finally getting it done. It will be good to get the Member-Owners equipment and material protected from the elements.
