Carbon has been working on their continuous improvement of our electrical facilities. Projects include:

Monolith Substation to Big Laramie Substation line rebuild. This will increase the reliability and load capabilities in all of the Laramie area.

Centennial Substation relocation and upsizing. This will increase reliability and capacity for the Centennial Valley.

Little Laramie Substation relocation and upsizing. This will increase reliability and capacity for the Little Laramie Valley mostly west of Interstate 80 and connects with the Centennial Substation. We are also rebuilding the three-phase circuit from Little Laramie Substation to the Quealy Dome exit on Interstate 80 following Hunt Road.

Walcott Junction to Rattle Snake Pass Road system improvement. This project will combine two substations and reroute facilities for improved inspection and access. We always test 10 percent of our poles annually to make sure they are sound and repair or replace as needed.

These are just some of the projects underway and we are completing new services and service improvements for you our Member-Owners.

# Energy Efficiency Tip of the Month


Old, uninsulated and improperly installed exterior doors can waste energy and money.


Shut the door on wasted energy by weather stripping and sealing all exterior doors. If you have an old exterior door, consider replacing it with a newer, energy efficient model.
